Our vet talks to your animals

Wee wee woes

Q My owners are starting to despair of me. I'm a nine-month-old terrier and I constantly wee around the house, even when I've been out for a walk. Thing is, I share my home with a five-month-old baby, and I need curing before she starts to crawl. Please help! **Jim, Farnham, Surrey**

A Your owners should get your vet to check you have no medical condition causing you to wee a lot. If you get a clean bill of health, then they need to persevere in teaching you where is, and where isn't, okay for you to go to the toilet.

Starting now, they should take you outside at regular intervals and give you lots of praise or a treat when you wee in the right place. You need to learn that going outside gets you lots of praise.

You should never be told off because the anxiety that could cause will make you learn more slowly.
